#### Parish Giving

Across the diocese this weekend, people are being asked to consider ways in which we can increase our offertory income, to help us to continue our mission of spreading the Gospel.

The money from the weekend collections, goes towards the salaries for myself and Fr Emmanuel, heating and lighting of the presbytery and Church, maintenance of the Churches etc. Also, a percentage of the money goes towards the work of the diocese, including our schools, Diocesan Youth Service.

I'm not a fan of suggesting a figure that people should give, as everyone's situation is different, and we are grateful for every penny that is given.

Over the years I have heard two good suggestions regarding the amount that people could give, one from Cardinal Hume and the other from Canon Geoffrey Hunton who I worked with in Nottingham. So I share them with you;

To work one hour a week for the Church.

To give the price of a pint or a bottle of wine.

However to increase our income, doesn't necessarily require people to dig deeper in to their pockets. If you are a tax payer, your offering can also be increased – without any extra cost to yourself. By gift aiding your offering the parish can claim back another 25p on every pound you give from the Government. So I would strongly encourage people to consider joining the Gift Aid Scheme and to have a look at the forms to gift aid your offering.

Another way in which you can support your parish is by leaving a legacy in your will. As a parish many people have kindly left the Church money in a legacy. The Legacies that have been left at Holy Souls and St Norbert's have been put aside to be used for improvements to the Church, hopefully in the coming months we will have details to share about projects being planned. Forms regarding Legacies are available at the back of the Church.

Finally, I wish to thank all of you for your generosity on a weekly/monthly basis, and for all the time and effort that is put in to making Holy Souls and St Norbert's the vibrant parishes that they are. *Fr Neil*

## Letter from Pope Emeritus Benedict XVI

This week a letter has been published in an Italian newspaper from Pope Emeritus Benedict XVI. Please continue to keep him in your prayers.

"...I can only say that with the slow decline of my physical forces, interiorly, I am on a pilgrimage towards Home. It is a great grace for me to be surrounded in this last, sometimes a little tiring, piece of road, by such love and goodness that I could not have imagined. In this sense, I also consider the question of your readers as an accompaniment along a stretch. This is why I cannot but be grateful, assuring all of you of my prayers. Best regards."
