

The six months have been challenging because of my new responsibilities, the pressures on the Deanery as a whole due to illness and from being quite a distance from home. This is the longest I have lived away from the Midlands and at times I do still get a little homesick. However, I wish to thank you for all your support and for your patience as I continue to adapt to my role as parish priest. Please continue to keep me in your prayers, and I pray for all of you as we approach Holy Week, which I hope will go smoothly!
