## Peoples Ponderings

As I write this pondering the people of the Republic of Ireland are voting on the referendum to save or repeal the 8<sup>th</sup> amendment, which recognises the human rights of the unborn child. Whatever way that result goes, it has been certainly a good thing for people here in the UK to reflect on the rights of unborn children. It has saddened me looking at twitter and Facebook to see the number of my friends who are Catholic that supported the repealing of the 8<sup>th</sup> amendment. As a Church we have obviously failed in proclaiming the dignity of life and the importance of protecting the unborn child. In the UK we now face greater opposition to the pro-life message, with prayer vigils now being banned at many abortion clinics.

Last week, the Conservative MP Jacob Rees-Mogg was again attacked for his Catholic beliefs on issues such as Gay Marriage and Abortion. There appears in recent years to be a concerted effort to silence religious views. As Catholics we can not just put our religious views in a box and not allow our faith to affect the way we live and the views that we hold. So, it is important that we continue to seek the help of the Holy Spirit to continue to guide and strengthen us in our efforts to proclaim the truth.
