In the last couple of weeks we have had a couple of big announcements, firstly Fr Emmanuel being appointed as Assistant in Hinckley and with no replacement coming. Secondly due to his move the need for us to make changes to the Mass times in this part of the deanery. During my time in seminary it was made clear to us, that we would be going out as priest's at a tough period in the Church, especially with the reducing numbers of clergy. A priest from my year group, who is a parish priest in Doncaster, is currently facing the challenge of closing one of his parishes, as the Diocese of Hallam looks to reorganise that deanery. We are not alone in the challenges we face and even though the changes we currently face are tough, it could be a lot worse. As I said last weekend, it is vitally important that we continue to pray for an increase in vocations and to encourage those that we think could make a good priest. If we don't, we will have to face even more changes in the years to come. Priest's don't grow on trees but they can be found in our families and our parish!
