Columban missionary work of evangelisation includes outreach to poor and marginalised peoples, building bridges between faiths and cultures and supporting emerging local churches. At the heart of their work is the call to help people become fully human, to help establish a world of peace with justice and care for the integrity of creation in solidarity with the poor. The appeal will be conducted by Fr Gerry Markey SSC who has worked on Mission around the globe in the Philippines, on the Mexican border in Ciudad Juarez and latterly in Chile.
