After the sign of the Cross, the priest presiding will welcome everyone with the words 'The Lord be with you' and the people respond 'and with your spirit'. It is important to remember that I am not welcoming you as Fr Neil – doing a posh hello, rather it is 'In Persona Christi Capitis' ~ in the person of Christ the Head. And I am welcoming you the people of God who are part of the mystical body of Christ.

It is a communication between the Head and the rest of the Body of Christ. At Adoremus, Bishop Robert Barron described how when he was a child the priest would say 'Thank you' after the response from the people and he wanted to say 'you're welcome'.
