## **Peoples** Ponderings

After the opening greeting, we move into the penitential act, the time when we acknowledge our sin. None of us like to admit that we are sinners, I have had members of my family say - I don't need confession, I don't sin! Well safe to say, after a short examination of conscience it became clear that they did!

Bishop Robert Barron used a simple way of looking at sin; when we are driving away from the Sun, our car window looks spotless, yet the minute we turn towards the sun, all the marks appear, and we realise it needs a good clean. So too with sin, when we turn away from the light, turn away from God - everything looks fine. It is only when we approach him that we realise that we are not perfect at all. That is why the Kyrie is so powerful - it is acknowledging our need for God's help -Lord have mercy on me!

As Catholics we don't claim to be perfect, we instead acknowledge that we are sinners who need God's mercy.
