As some of you will know, I was not able to make it on retreat last week due to back problems. I have been struggling for the past few months and have tried the chiropractor and now tablets from the doctor. Hopefully this weekend you will see me again. The pain has not completely gone, and I may well have to go back to see the doctor again. I am grateful for the kind wishes and offers of help during the past few days, it was very much appreciated.

What did become clear is that we will have to put in place an emergency Mass timetable for weekends, if myself or Mgr Tom are not well. This would mean in an emergency only one Mass would be said in each parish and in the coming weeks we will try to come up with an emergency plan. An example of a possible solution would be: evening Mass at St Thomas's, Gainsborough, 9.00 am at Holy Souls, 11.00 am at St Bernadette's and a Sunday evening Mass in Crowle. This timetable would only come in to use if we are unable to find supply, ie in the event of sudden illness.

Fr Neil is considering doing a Parish Census in the coming months which will include a section where you can give permission for your name to be published in The Reminder and on-line.

Marriages

To get married at Holy Souls or St Norbert's Crowle, you need to give a minimum of six months notice. This is so that we can sort out all the paperwork and to ensure that marriage preparation is done. *Please note* that if you live in this parish and wish to get married in another Church in the UK or abroad, your paperwork will need to be completed here and then sent on to the parish where you wish to get married. Again you need to give us a minimum of six months notice.
