Incredibly we find ourselves in the month of November. During this month, the Church invites us to pray for those who have died, to assist them on their journey to heaven. Praying for the dead is an important part of our Catholic faith and reminds us how our loved ones are still connected to us.

During this month the names of your loved ones will be placed before the altar with Masses celebrated during the month and throughout the year for the repose of their souls.

Masses can be requested during the year, for those who have died, those who are sick or for a special occasion. The recommended offering is £10 but please don't let this suggested offering put you off requesting a Mass! It is an offering towards the upkeep of your priest and not buying a Mass, so give what you can.
