Deacon's deliberations

As you will now be aware, Fr Neil has returned home to Leicester for a period of convalescence following his recent back surgery. Before undergoing surgery, Fr Neil received the Sacrament of the Sick – that holy anointing which brings physical and spiritual healing to our bodies. And yet, as Catholics, there is sometimes a reluctance on our part to receive the Sacraments of Healing, usually because we still tend to think about the Sacrament of the Sick as being 'The Last Rites'. The truth is, as Fr Neil so powerfully demonstrated, is that you don't have to be dying to receive the Sacrament of the Sick – we don't have to wait until we are dying to ask the Lord to come to heal us.

Lent is also our annual opportunity to seek the other Sacrament of Healing by going to Confession, asking the Lord to forgive the times we have fallen, and asking him for the grace to strive again for that holiness of life that we are called to by virtue of our baptism. This Sunday let us continue to pray for Fr Neil as he continues to recover, for ourselves that will have the courage to turn to God asking him to heal us both physically and spiritually, and especially for our mothers – both living and deceased.
