Deacon's Deliberations

This Sunday's Gospel recounts the familiar story of the woman 'caught in the very act of adultery', but you don't have to be an adulterer to find a resonance in Jesus' teaching today. Before I came to Scunthorpe, I ministered as Catholic Chaplain to HMP Birmingham. Prison ministry was a great joy to me, but I also saw much suffering and sadness. The root of so many of the men's convictions lay in the fact that they had sought love in the wrong places and the wrong ways and had got lost along the way. I always tried to encourage the men to see facts about their pasts not defining who the Lord called them to be in the future.

Whenever and however we sin, it is fundamentally a failure to love God and neighbour – or having sought love in the wrong place - just like the woman in the Gospel. Today, let us pray for the grace to gently let go of those things which do not lead us to God's love, and for the grace to believe that our pasts do not define who the Lord Jesus is calling us to be. Never forget, no sin is unforgivable, and that grace has the power to change us – no matter how ingrained we might feel our shortcomings are.
