Deacon's Deliberations

This Sunday marks a gear shift if you like, when our focus moves from that repentance and call to conversion which has marked our Lenten journey, to concentrating on Our Lord's sacred and sorrowful passion. Palm Sunday begins with Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem, and ends in his anguished cry of abandonment on the cross and his death. In each of our lives there are times of 'spiritual triumph' when we know and feel God's providential love for us, and also times when we share that sense of abandonment and anguish.

As one, please God, preparing for priestly ordination later this summer, I am struck by the words that the Bishop speaks to the newly ordained 'Accept from the holy people of God the gifts to be offered to him. Know what you are doing, and imitate the mystery you celebrate: model your life on the mystery of the Lord's cross'. However, these words are not simply applicable to the newly ordained, but to each of us. We are all called to enter into the mystery of the cross, and to share in the sufferings of Christ. But we do not shoulder the cross alone, nor do we face anguish and abandonment alone, if we invite the Lord into our lives and allow His power to transform our personal sufferings into glory.
