We have started the month of May, which the Church has traditionally dedicated to Our Blessed Mother Mary. It is a time when we are encouraged to improve our relationship with the Mother of our Saviour and one of the best ways we can do that is by praying the Rosary. Sometimes doing the whole Rosary can seem a little daunting, so it might be good to start with just doing one of the Mysterious – so just one decade. In 2020 England will be rededicated to Our Lady (we hold the title of Mary's Dowry). As part of the preparations for this important event the statue of Our Lady of Walsingham is on a tour of the Catholic Cathedrals. She is due to be in St Barnabas Cathedral, Nottingham, from 10th to 12th October. My hope is that we can arrange a coach from Scunthorpe. I also hope to run the CAFÉ course on Our Lady in the month of October.
