Peoples Ponderings

Over the last couple of days we have celebrated First Holy Communion at Holy Souls. Like in previous years we have had a large number of children on the programme. This has made it all the more worrying that we have so few young people receiving the Sacrament of Confirmation and have had to join up with St Bernadette's. Where have all the children that have received their First Holy Communion over recent years gone? This situation is not unique to us, but it is sadly worrying trend that is affecting the Church.

In 1969 the then Cardinal Ratzinger (Pope Benedict XVI) said 'From the crisis of today the Church of to-morrow will emerge - a Church that has lost much. She will become small and will have to start afresh more or less from the beginning.'

I wonder have we reached that stage or is more decline due to happen first? The danger is that we become resigned to reducing congregations, reduced numbers receiving the Sacraments - particularly Confirmation, Holy Orders and Marriage and just allow ourselves to go down without a fight!

During Easter we read from the Acts of the Apostles and hear about the energy of the early Church. The whole community going out and evangelising - sharing the joy of the Gospel. I would ask that we all reflect on how well we are doing in that regard today. How have I shared the Good News of Jesus Christ to the people I meet. How serious am I taking my faith? Are we ready to fight or have we already surrenthe people I meet. How serious am I taking my faith? Are we ready to fight or have we already surrendered to decline?
