Today we celebrate Corpus Christi, an important celebration, as it reminds us that the Eucharist is the 🛛 Source and Summit of our Christian faith. It is a time when we can reflect on the importance of the Blessed 🔯 Sacrament in our lives, how we act in the presence of the Lord when we enter Church, how we adore the Lord at the times of elevation during the Mass and how reverently we receive Holy Communion. It always surprises me when I read about Bishops and Priests in other countries that have become dictator-like about the reception of Holy Communion. In some places people are not allowed to receive kneeling down or told that they must remain standing after receiving Communion until everyone has received – in my mind this is all madness and certainly not an instruction from the universal church. Cardinal Arinze once said in an interview 'If you believe that Christ is our God and is present, why don't you kneel, why don't you crawl, why not show respect'. Now let me make clear, that I am not dictating that people should kneel or crawl to Communion but I do encourage you to come forward respectfully, to concentrate on who you are about to receive, rather than saying hello to people on your way to or from the Altar.

As you know the Diocese over recent years, has been looking at restructuring of Parishes, due to reduced numbers of clergy. Our Deanery has made quite a few changes already but we have asked to consider one more change. This change will see one Parish Priest and one assistant priest looking after Holy Souls, St Bernadette's, St Norbert's and St Thomas of Canterbury. In response to this request we will be having a PPC meeting to discuss possible ways forward and then in September a joint meeting of all PPCs concerned. When we have more information I will let you know. NB: there is no plans for closures or weekend Masses to change.
