Work update

It has been good to hear the many positive comments on the work done so far on the Church. Fr Neil wishes to clarify a couple of points, which seem to be causing a little confusion:

- ◆ The image of Our Lady of Czestochowa, will be moved in to the organ chamber and have a light on her. The statue of Our Lady will be returning, with the Sacred Heart statue, once work in that area is complete.
- The cost of the work being done will be around £65-75k. This will be covered by the legacies left to the Church and Fr Neil will not be using any of the offset account to cover any of this work.

Contributions towards the work and Deacon Bernard's window

Legacies will cover the majority of the redecoration work, but we would still welcome any donations towards it and also to the installation of the windows in memory of Deacon Bernard. In the coming months we will have an occasional second collection to help raise funds. Fr Neil will work out when is best to have them so that we are not hit with too many second collections at one time.

'You are Living Stones'

As you know the Diocese over recent years, has been looking at restructuring of Parishes, due to reduced numbers of clergy. Our Deanery has made quite a few changes already but we have asked to consider one more change. This change will see one Parish Priest and one assistant priest looking after Holy Souls, St Bernadette's, St Norbert's and St Thomas of Canterbury. In response to this request we will be having a PPC meeting to discuss possible ways forward and then in September a joint meeting of all PPCs concerned. When we have more information I will let you know. NB: there is no plans for closures or weekend Masses to change.
