Work update

It has been good to hear the many positive comments on the work done so far on the Church. Fr Neil wishes to clarify a couple of points, which seem to be causing a little confusion:

- ♦ The image of Our Lady of Czestochowa, will be moved in to the organ chamber and have a light on her. The statue of Our Lady will be returning, with the Sacred Heart statue, once work in that area is complete.
- ♦ The cost of the work being done will be around £65-75k. This will be covered by the legacies left to the Church and Fr Neil will not be using any of the offset account to cover any of this work.
