The Canon's Comments

Since my arrival in Scunthorpe to replace Fr Neil as Parish Priest of Holy Souls, I have become conscious of a sense of grief at not only the loss of your Parish Priest but also the loss of a Priest residing at Holy Souls' Presbytery and concerns about the security of the Church, Hall and Presbytery.

This I am afraid, is a situation that is being repeated not only in our Diocese of Nottingham, but also in the other Dioceses of England and Wales. The ratio of active Priests to Parishes has fallen significantly over the past few years and Bishops and Priests throughout the country have had to take some difficult decisions as to how best allocate the Clergy to serve the people as best they can.

My first and only priority is to serve the people of all four Parishes that the Bishop has appointed me to, as best I can, and I assure you that applies very much to you, the parishioners of Holy Souls', as it does to the parishioners of St Bernadette's, St Thomas and St Norbert's.

Over the preceding years much necessary maintenance, beautiful restoration and decorative work has been undertaken at the Church of Holy Souls', the results of which shall shortly bear fruit and be blessed by Bishop Patrick during Mass on Tuesday 5th November. Likewise, we have been greatly blessed by an up-to-date adjoining Parish Hall which serves the Parish well and I would hope also in the future will serve the wider community of the Parish.

The Presbytery at Holy Souls was, I understand, built in the 1920's adjacent to the Church, and has over the previous 90 years or more, provided a home for many a beloved past Parish Priest and Assistant Priest. It is a credit to theirs, yours and those of past generations that Holy Souls' Parish remains a significant feature of our community and that of the town of Scunthorpe to the present day.

The Presbytery and the grounds, however, need a significant amount of maintenance, particularly the Presbytery. As you are aware, rainwater has been seeping into the safe of the Sacristy and a temporary repair job has been undertaken to tide us over. In addition to this, several of the trees in the garden require urgent attention. I am hoping to meet with various contractors over the coming weeks to get a fuller picture of what is required to bring the Presbytery up to a reasonable standard of decoration and furnishing and, more importantly that the Presbytery meets necessary Health and Safety regulations, *ie* gas, electricity and alarm systems.

As I get a fuller of picture of what needs doing I will keep you informed. With every good wish and blessing
