The Canon's Comments

The Gospel from Luke this weekend continues with the theme
of persistence in prayer. Throughout St Luke's Gospel he of-
fers frequent hints about the necessity for prayer to be central
in all we do in our lives and illustrates this quite liberally with
examples of Our Lord at prayer at important times during his
life and ministry. Likewise, other significant characters, such
as Our Lady, Zechariah and Simeon, are shown bursting into
prayer when faced with the reality of God's presence in their
lives - eg The Magnificat, The Benedictus and The Nunc
Dimittus. As we have seen, Luke's parables always insist on
prayer at those most important times. Refer to the parable
about the Friend at Midnight and the parable of the Unjust
Judge we listened to last week. Today, in this parable of the
Pharisee and the Tax-Collector, Luke combines deadly ear-
nestness with humour, as is his way. The pompous and self-
contradictory bragging of innocence by Pharisee is repellent,
while the humble self-accusation of the Tax-Collector is
something to which we can all aspire. (HW).
