

14th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Reflection: Matthew 11:25-30

This much-loved and encouraging passage tells of the intimacy of the relationship between Father and Son in a way that no other passage of the synoptic gospels does. It is reminiscent of those passages in John 5 which unfold the equality of Father and Son: the Son does nothing but what he sees the Father doing; the Father loves the Son so that he entrusts all things to the Son, and the Son gives life just as the Father gives life. Then comes the gentle invitation of the Son to all who are overburdened. The "voke" is often a symbol of the Law of Moses, which could be seen burdensome with its many commands, though it was also valued as God's revelation of himself to his own people in love. Christ is not a tyrannical master, but is a sympathetic, gentle and humble leader who shares his life with his followers. The "yoke" or law of Christ, as we saw with regard to the second reading, is the interior impulse of the Spirit. It cannot be burdensome, since it is a joy to carry, a way of living with Christ and his Spirit. Even the joy of martyrs, subjected as they are to physical pains, is a constant feature of accounts of martyrdom. Canon Geoffrey

Celebration of Mass

- \Rightarrow Holy Souls' and St Bernadette's Churches are to open for the celebration of Mass from Saturday 4th July 2020, and at the times advertised in the newsletters, on the websites and Facebook.
- \Rightarrow Attendance as you are aware is by pre-booking only. Do not just turn up unless you have booked a place at Mass. This is due to a limit on the numbers permissible in the Church.
- Booking can be by email or telephone to St Bernadette's. It is on a first-come-first-served basis and a waiting list system will be in place.
- \Rightarrow Social distancing will be set at 2 metres, so please observe this as you arrive and leave Church.
- If you are in the extremely clinically vulnerable (shielding) category, then please continue to protect yourself by staying at home and praying for the parish community or accessing a live stream Mass.
- \Rightarrow The Sunday obligation continues to be suspended, so if you are unsure about coming, do not feel unthen please stay at home.
- When planning to come to Mass, if you have booked, please be aware that you may be asked to wait outside until invited in to take a seat.
- Please arrive in time to allow for this managed arrival to take place and for Mass to start on time.
- Stewards will assist with arriving and leaving Church so that people are kept safe.
- Singing: the Government guidance stresses that singing is to be 'specifically avoided'.
- ⇒ Distribution of Holy Communion: Communion is to be given hand to hand only and that social disfering people the choice of receiving Holy Communion either on the hand or on the tongue.
- Please do not congregate in the Church or outside of the Church outside of your household group.
- Please do follow all the necessary guideline and instructions they have been put in place to ensure your safety and the safety of all in our communities.
- Further information will be made available when arriving at Mass.
