21st Sunday in Ordinary Time

Reflection: Matthew 16:13-20

At last Peter recognises that Jesus is the Messiah, the Christ. At last he realises that in Jesus they can see the action of God. The disciples followed Jesus as soon as he called, but for a long time they were puzzled what to make of him, of his wonderful teaching and his godlike personality. Now comes a shaft of light and understanding. We too often take some time to appreciate the truth worth of someone we know well: a little gesture can sometimes reveal just how generous and thoughtful they are. Peter suddenly grasps that there is God acting among them, a daunting or terrifying thought. Jesus replies to Peter's recognition with his own generosity, giving him a new name, "Rock", for this is what "Peter" means. If you name something, you make it your own, take it to yourself. This is just what Jesus does with Simon who becomes his own Peter. That is the importance of the naming of a child at Baptism; Jesus takes us to himself and we become his. The early Christians called themselves "Those over whom the name of Jesus has been called." We may have been named Mary or John, but the name of Jesus has been called over us and we have become his. From 8th August 2020 you must wear a face covering, by law, in places of worship

The Sunday obligation continues to be suspended, so if you are unsure about coming to Mass, do not feel under any obligation to attend.

If you or someone in your household displays symptoms of Covid 19, then please stay at home.

In accordance with the Diocesan directive a 2 metre social distancing policy has been implemented in our Churches. This means that only a limited number of worshippers can attend Mass and the Sacraments.

You do not need to wear a face covering if you have a legitimate reason not to. This includes (but is not limited to):

- young children under the age of 11 (Public Health England do not recommended face coverings for children under the age of 3 for health and safety reasons)

- not being able to put on, wear or remove a face covering because of a physical or mental illness or impairment, or disability

How to book your seats at Public Masses

⇒ **Saturday and Sunday Masses.** Parishioners can now book seats at weekend Masses at St Bernadette's Church and at Holy Souls' Church through this Diocese of Nottingham website:

After you have logged in you can view all the weekend Mass services scheduled at each Church and the availability of seats. Family pews and individual seats can be booked and you can receive immediate confirmation of the booking by email or by viewing your booking history.

If you are unable to book online you can: email St Bernadette's Office at stbernadettesash-by@gmail.com or telephone 01724 844895 Tuesday to Thursday between 11.00 am and 1.00 pm. You will be notified to confirm your reservation or, if the Mass is fully booked, details of the availability of seats at other Masses will be provided.

⇒ **Weekday Masses.** Admission is on a 'first come, first served' basis. You will need to provide your name and contact details for NHS Test and Trace purposes.

⇒ **Private Masses.** These include First Holy Communion, Baptisms, Weddings and Requiem Masses. As Government and Diocesan guidelines stipulate that social distancing is maintained at all times, there are only limited places available. These seats are reserved by the families only.
