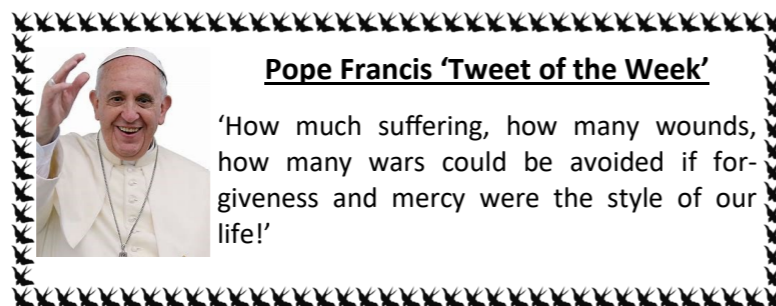

## 25th Sunday in Ordinary Time

### Reflection: Isaiah 55:6-9

This the triumphant conclusion of the second major section of the Book of Isaiah: God's ways are utterly different from human thinking. In many ways it is comforting to think that God is not like ourselves. One reason why we cling to God is to be liberated from ourselves and to be brought into his marvellous light, living a life freed from restrictions, frustrations and self-centeredness that surrounds and penetrates us. Obviously God does not have our faults of selfishness, laziness, malice, lust, and greed. More than that, not being bodily or limited in any way God does not plan or think like ourselves. God does not think things out, with "Yes" and "No", working in concepts or sentences. God does not laboriously plan what to do weighing consequences, advantages and disadvantages! Even our life is always tinged with self-interest and concern for ourselves. God's love is entirely generous and out-going, a limitless cascade of love, deluging and penetrating each of us.

### +++++ Polite Reminder +++++

Recently a number of people have been "turning up" to attend Sunday Mass without prior booking. **You need to book a place in advance** for the weekend Masses otherwise you risk being turned away. It is only the weekday Masses where you can currently attend without booking although this is being kept under review. Details of how to book are shown below.

In accordance with the Diocesan directive a 2 metre social distancing policy has been implemented in our Churches. This means that only a limited number of worshippers can attend Mass and the Sacraments. As the Sunday obligation continues to be suspended, please consider attending a weekday Mass instead of a weekend Mass, if you are able to do so. This will allow parishioners with work and school commitments on weekdays to be able to attend a Mass at the weekend. Seats at the weekday masses are allocated on a 'first come, first served' basis and there are usually spare seats remaining at these Masses.

**Please stay at home if you, or someone in your household, displays symptoms of Covid 19**

### By law, you must now wear a face covering in places of worship

You do not need to wear a face covering if you have a legitimate reason not to. This includes (but is not limited to):

- young children under the age of 11 (Public Health England do not recommend face coverings for children under the age of 3 for health and safety reasons)
- not being able to put on, wear or remove a face covering because of a physical or mental illness or impairment, or disability

### How to book your seats at Public Masses

⇒ **Saturday and Sunday Masses.** Parishioners can now book seats at weekend Masses at St Bernadette's Church and at Holy Souls' Church through this Diocese of Nottingham website: <https://massbooking.uk> After you have logged in you can view all the weekend Mass services scheduled at each Church and the availability of seats. Family pews and individual seats can be booked and you can receive immediate confirmation of the booking by email or by viewing your booking history. If you are unable to book online you can email St Bernadette's Office at [stbernadettesashby@gmail.com](mailto:stbernadettesashby@gmail.com) or telephone 01724 844895 Tuesday to Thursday between 11.00 am and 1.00 pm. You will be notified to confirm your reservation or, if the Mass is fully booked, details of the availability of seats at other Masses will be provided.

⇒ **Private Masses.** These include First Holy Communion, Baptisms, Weddings and Requiem Masses. As Government and Diocesan guidelines stipulate that social distancing is maintained at all times, there are only limited places available. These seats are reserved by the families only.
