Reflection: Isaiah 25:6-10

The reading begins with the image of the messianic banquet, the banquet which the Lord is preparing for the end of time, an image which Jesus takes up in the gospel story of the wedding-feast. After the first lines the image changes to the removal of the mourning veil and the destruction of death, every tear wiped away. In the earlier parts of the Bible the dead are thought to lead a wretched existence in Sheol, a life which is no life, a sort of half existence without power or substance, when the dead cannot praise God. Gradually Israel comes to realise that God's love is so enveloping and so enduring that God cannot desert or abandon his faithful even in death. Even death cannot cut off the faithful from God. This is one of the crucial passages where the permanent saving strength of God's love is expressed.
