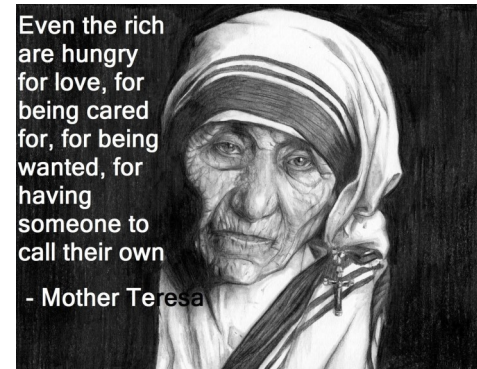
'In Prayer, we place our worries and petitions in the hands of God, and we trust that He will listen, for He knows what we need and will give us what is good for us.'

In accordance with the Diocesan directive a 2 metre social distancing policy has been implemented in our Churches. This means that only a limited number of worshippers can attend Mass and the Sacraments. As the Sunday obligation continues to be suspended, please consider attending a weekday Mass instead of a weekend Mass, if you are able to do so. This will allow parishioners with work and school commitments on weekdays to be able to attend a Mass at the weekend. Seats at the weekday masses are allocated on a 'first come, first served' basis and there are usually spare seats remaining at these Masses.

⇒ **Service of The Word.** Due to Canon's unavailability, this Sunday the 6.30 pm Mass will now be a Service of The Word and Holy Communion. Sincere thanks to Deacon Sebastian for stepping into the breach at such short notice.

⇒ **Please note** that from Saturday 24th October there will no longer be an English language Vigil Mass at 6.00 pm. Because of social distancing rules and the need for an additional Polish language "Sunday" Mass there will be a Vigil Mass celebrated in the Polish language at 6.00 pm instead.
