The Sunday obligation continues to be suspended, so if you are unsure about coming to Mass, do not feel under any obligation to attend. If you or someone in your household displays symptoms of Covid 19, then please stay at home.

In accordance with Government coronavirus legislation and Diocesan Directives our Churches are restricted as to the *number* of worshippers who can safely attend Mass and the Sacraments to ensure that we meet our legal obligations so that public worship can take place. These measures include maintaining a 2 metre social distancing policy inside our Churches, that there should be separate entrances and exits and sufficient stewards and cleaners present.

As the weekend Masses are proving very popular with seats being booked up quickly each week, we would be grateful if you could please consider attending a weekday Mass instead of a weekend Mass, if you are able to do so. Seats at the weekday masses are allocated on a 'first come, first served' basis and there are usually seats available to accommodate worshippers. By doing so, it will allow those parishioners who are unable to attend a weekday Mass due to work and school commitments, to be able to reserve seats at a weekend Mass.
