Dear Sisters and Brothers.

As you know, it is an honourable custom that, when a priest leaves a parish, parishioners who wish to do so are given the opportunity to contribute towards a leaving present for him to thank him for his ministry and to wish him well for the future.

Many of you have asked Fr Liam and me about what we can do to say thank you and farewell to Canon Geoffrey, and so there will be a collection basket at the back of each Church this weekend, through the week and next weekend, so that those who wish to may contribute something towards a leaving gift for Canon Geoffrey. Since he is parish priest of all four parishes entrusted to his care, there will be one collection across all four parishes, which will then be consolidated and presented as one gift from us all. "Priesthood - while the whole Church is a priestly people, sharing in the priesthood of Christ by their daily sacrifices, prayers and spreading of the Gospel, God calls specific people to serve in his name in the midst of the Church as ordained priests. Just as he called the first apostles to continue his work on earth, Jesus still calls men to lay down their lives in service to his Church as priests. The ordained priesthood is the visible sacramental way through which the mission of Christ the Eternal Priest continues and God's grace is experienced in the world today. The priesthood is not simply one occupation among many. It is a calling and a way of life through which God invites a man to enter more deeply into relationship with him. The priesthood is a life of sacrifice and a life of service because it is the life of Christ."
