As most of you will know, Fr Liam was appointed Chaplain General of the Society on Ash Wednesday and we offer him our sincere congratulations.

The Society of St Justin Martyr was founded in 2005 by a group of Catholic friends in England. It originally functioned in the UK only as a confraternity for those who wished to honour the memory of those who had worshipped in the Cathedrals, Churches and Monasteries of the UK prior to, and during the protestant reformation. Now membership has spread to other countries across the world.

Making pilgrimage to ruined or former places of Catholic worship and praying for the living and the dead (a spiritual work of mercy) is at the heart of what members do, privately or in groups. The duty of members is simply to offer one Pater Noster, Ave Maria and Gloria Patri during those visits on behalf of past and present worshippers, as an act of reparation for past wrongs and for the Unity of Christ's Church.

Members have a share in the fruits of monthly Masses offered by the Chaplains of the Society.
