Fr. Matthew's Weekly Catechism: The Transfiguration of Christ

On Friday of this week we celebrate the feast of the Transfiguration of the Lord. The Orthodox Icon of the Transfiguration depicts Jesus at the top of a very steep mountain, his glory radiating from him. The apostles look as though they are tumbling down the sides of the Mount of Transfiguration. They are unable to view the glory of Christ. It is too dazzling for them. Similarly, Moses had to put a veil over his face to disguise the divine glory as it radiated from him after his meetings with God on Mount Sinai as the dazzling reflected glory of God was too much for human beings to look at. In same way the glory of Christ is too much for the apostles to bear. Jesus showed his glory to the apostles at that time because he was approaching his suffering and death. Unless they had glimpsed his glory, however briefly, it is thought that they would have found the events of Holy Week unbearable. The Transfiguration reminds us of our destiny. We, and the whole of God's creation are destined to share in the dazzling divine glory the apostles witnessed. This is because of the saving power of Christ's death for the whole Universe, so that now every created thing is as it were slanted to glory. We are all undergoing the process of divinization (coming to share in God's glory). Just as Christ was destined to suffer and to die before he entered his glory, in the same way all of our trials and sufferings in this life are but stepping stones in the direction of divine glory. Our salvation and our sharing in the divine nature are not inevitable. We must cooperate and be open to grace in order to be assured of redemption. So, let's try our best to follow God's commandments and live as good Christians, so that one day we can be assured that we will be with Christ

We ask that parishioners:

- Support NHS Test, Track and Trace by signing in with the QR code if you have a smartphone. There will also be slips of paper for parishioners to provide their contact details to post in the box provided.
- Sanitise your hands when entering and leaving church.
- Wear a face covering unless you are exempt from doing so for medical reasons.

- Place your offertory collection in the basket as you arrive for or leave after Mass
