**Sts Michael, Gabriel and Raphael, Archangels**

On 29th September, we commemorate Sts Michael, Raphael and Gabriel, the Archangels. They are the three archangels named in sacred Scripture, reminding us of the angelic world and of their constant service to our world. St Michael (meaning "Who is like God") is venerated as captain of the heavenly army, victor over Satan, protector of the Church, and helper of the sick and dying. The feast originated as that of the dedication of the Roman basilica in his honour.

St Gabriel (meaning "Strength of God") announced both the birth of St John the Baptist to Zechariah, and of Jesus Christ to the Blessed Virgin Mary. His greeting at the Annunciation has become one of our most familiar prayers in the first few words of the Hail Mary: "Hail full of grace."

St Raphael (meaning "God heals") took care of Tobias on his journey, as described in the book of Tobit. He is often also associated with the angel in the sheep pool mentioned in the Gospel of John. He is the patron of the blind, travellers and physicians and nurses.

The feast challenges our western rationalism. We find it very difficult to believe in an unseen spiritual world. We want to restrict reality to what we feel comfortable with. Sacred Scripture and Tradition however challenge us to see things differently, and to believe in the unseen world. Let us ask for the grace to be less rationalist and more Christian in our outlook.

**Covid Guidelines**

Everyone is welcome to come to Church and we encourage the following:

- If you have the NHS COVID-19 app installed on your smartphone, you can help prevent the spread of coronavirus by scanning the QR code in each Church; alternatively, there are signing-in slips which we will keep for three weeks if you do not have the app.
- That face coverings continue to be worn at Mass, unless you are exempt.
- That you sanitise your hands on entering and leaving the Church.
- That, where possible, you try to leave two seats between you and other people not in your group.
- Do not come into the Church if you have any symptoms of Covid-19 or have been asked to self-isolate having come into contact with someone with the virus.

The doors and windows of our Churches must be left open before, during and after Mass to help reduce the risk of transmission of COVID-19; this is even more important as we move towards winter, so please wear warm clothing when coming into our Churches and bring a cushion and water with you if you need them for your comfort.
