Chair of St. Peter 22nd February

Our liturgy today does not revolve around a piece of furniture, as the title might suggest. It rather draws attention to the position of leadership in the Church. Peter was designated by Jesus to be "chairman of the board." The term "chair" refers to the seat of power, and the place from which an organization is controlled. In a parish council we have a chair, who gives order to the proceedings. Universities have their various chairs of philosophy, science, English etc. The term comes from the Latin word "cathedra" meaning chair. Thus the cathedral is the church where the chair of the bishop is located. The same concept is carried over into every parish church. Here the chair of the one who presides at the liturgy is found in a prominent place, representing the authority of the bishop, and the parish priest who represents him. Note also that a chair is a seat for only one person, as opposed to a pew or bench. The Pope's chair in Rome is a visible sign of papal leadership. It commemorates the two hundred and sixty-six popes who have held that exalted office. Let me quote Pope St. Leo the great in the fifth century:
 "One man, Peter, was chosen out from the whole world to preside over the calling of the nations, over all the apostles and all the fathers of the Church."
