Passiontide

Traditionally the Fifth Sunday of Lent was Passion Sunday, and it marked the beginning of Passiontide. In Passiontide the focus shifts from Jesus' prayerful preparation in the desert to his suffering and death on the Cross. Although we no longer refer to the Fifth Sunday of Lent as Passion Sunday, the beautiful customs associated with this time are permitted to continue in our churches and homes.

The traditional Gospel reading for Passion Sunday concludes, "So they took up stones to throw at him; but Jesus hid himself, and went out of the temple." (Jn 8:59). From Jesus hiding himself after being rejected by the crowds comes our tradition of veiling statues and crucifixes in church and at home during this time. If you don't have a crucifix in your home, now might be the time to consider getting one. You could also enter into the spirit of penitence, preparing for Easter by obtaining some cheap purple cloth and covering your crucifix until Easter.

all who have died recently, may they rest in peace. *Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon them. May the souls of the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in peace. Amen.* Please pray for their families at this difficult time; for those whose anniversaries occur at this time; for all who are sick and housebound and those who have no family to support them. We remember all those who are in hospital or are having treatment, those whose treatment has been cancelled or postponed and those who are in nursing homes or being cared for

Second Collection for Ukraine

Message from Fr Matthew (20th March): "On each of the four Sundays between now and Palm Sunday a second collection will be taken for the relief of Ukrainian refugees. The funds will be given to CAFOD, which has a sister charity, Caritas Internationalis, working within the war zone, and the bordering countries. The proceeds of the collections will assist with food, water, shelter and medical supplies for the three million people who have now been displaced by this terrible war. In the middle of winter suddenly they find themselves without anything, even the basic essentials. I have decided that we will have four collections because this is a situation which has been unprecedented in Europe since World War II. Envelopes are on order and will follow soon. Please think of how fortunate we are in this country and give as generously as you can."
