### Easter Message from Fr Matthew and Fr Limnyuy

Dear Parishioners,  
We write to wish you a very happy Easter. Thank you for all your support and prayers throughout the year, and a special thank you to all who helped with the Holy Week ceremonies, whether by preparing the Churches or by taking on roles within the Liturgies. It is so good to see things returning to normal after the terrible two years of the pandemic.

Today we commemorate Christ having risen from the dead, and having conquered death on our behalf. It was only God who could conquer death for us, and it was only possible for God to die by taking on our human nature. For the redemption two things were necessary. God had to give us his divine power to conquer death, and Mary had to provide him with our human nature in order that he could die on our behalf. This is why the author of the letter to the Hebrews said "Without the shedding of blood there could be no redemption." This is also why the Fathers of the Church have constantly taught us that in Christ, truly God and truly man, "Death was swallowed up by life." God is life and the source of all life. He does not desire the death of the living as it says in the Book of Wisdom. And so, it follows that he decided from all eternity to conquer death through his Son.
