## News from St Bernadette's Presbytery by Fr Matthew

Two things of note have happened in the presbytery garden of late. Firstly when I was isolating from Covid recently, with mild symptoms, I had to do something to keep active and use my time well. So I decided to order a hedge on the internet. A few days later the hedge arrived. This consisted of about 100 small shrubs. It is a native hedge of hawthorne, blackthorn, wild cherry, field maple, holly, dog rose and a few other native plants. I chose this because it would be green, off-setting our carbon footprint as a parish. It is also very good for wildlife when mature. The whole thing took me about three days to plant, three or four hours work each day. It will cover over a tall wrought iron fence which is rather ugly. Luckily, although I had Covid, I didn't feel ill for most of the eight days of isolation, so this was time well spent.

Another thing happened last week associated with the presbytery garden. I was woken up at 4.15 am by my dog which has taken to sleeping on the floor in my bedroom for most of the night. A large paw hit my face, and I woke to find two eyes boring into mine. From this I concluded he was telling me he needed to go out into the garden to do his business. When I went out with him, there were no poos or wees. Instead, his attention was elsewhere, his nose stuck to the ground. He was obviously on the trail of something. I followed behind with interest, and he took me to the largest hedgehog I have ever seen after a circuit of the garden. I draw two conclusions from this, that no one and nothing can enter church premises without Myrddin knowing about it. Secondly, I presume he smelled the hedgehog out via the open bedroom window-what a powerful sense of smell.
