Evangelii Gaudium Sunday, 18th September 2022

Formerly known as Home Mission Sunday. Evangelii Gaudium Sunday calls us to be joyous in proclaiming our faith. "Evangelii Gaudium" is Latin for "Joy of the Gospel". The day supports the work carried out by the Mission Directorate at the Bishops' Conference in supporting our bishops in evangelisation and catechesis, the beauty of the Liturgy and our church buildings and sharing the beauty of the Catholic faith with Christian and non-Christians through outreach and dialogue. Our Lady of Walsingham - 24th September

On this day we celebrate the memorial of Our Lady of Walsingham. England's premier shrine dates back to 1061, when a wealthy widow, Richeldis de Faverches, was inspired by a vision to build a replica of the Holy House of Nazareth in Walsingham, Norfolk. Throughout the Middle Ages this remained a vibrant place of pilgrimage. It is said to have been the third most visited place of pilgrimage in Christendom, after Rome and Jerusalem. Many miracles were reported and people came from far and wide with petitions at the Holy House. People would leave their shoes at the so-called Slipper Chapel and, as a penance, walk the last mile to the Holy shrine barefoot. The shrine was unfortunately destroyed at the Reformation in 1538. However, in recent years the shrine has been revived. The Slipper Chapel came into Catholic hands in the late C19th, and the Catholic shrine was revived in 1897. The Anglicans of the High Church built their own shrine in 1922. The Orthodox Christians now also have three chapels in or near the village. Formerly this Feast was known as Our Lady of Ransom, when prayers were offered for the ransom or conversion of England, a land known as "Our Lady's Dowry." Yes, we need to pray for the conversion of England back to the true faith. Who knows one day it might happen. But let's also remember that Walsingham, and devotion to Our Lady, is drawing Christians together from various traditions, so today is also a day to pray for the unity of Christians. May we be reminded on this memorial that Mary is our Mother, and she cares for us her children with a mother's love.

School admissions to Catholic Secondary Academies (Year 7) - Children born between 01/09/2011 and 31/08 2012

The deadline for submitting your application for a school place is 31st October 2022. Application forms are available on your 'home' Local Authority website. For every Catholic school you apply for if you wish your child to be considered and ranked under a faith criterion you *must also complete a supplementary information form*, and return this form to the school by the deadline, (forms are available from the LA and the school). You MUST also include the *supporting evidence* as required eg baptism certificate (photocopies are acceptable). Failure to supply the required supporting evidence will mean your child is ranked in a lower criterion which may affect your chance of a place. If you do not have the required evidence please contact the parish where your child was baptised for a copy certificate in good time.

CSSA Safeguarding Training

The Catholic Safeguarding Standards Agency (CSSA) have launched Safeguarding training to be completed by volunteers who require a DBS.
