## St Francis of Assisi ~ 4th October

St Francis was the son of a wealthy merchant in Assisi, Italy. He responded to the call of God, embraced poverty, and preached the love of God to all. In 1210 Pope Innocent III approved his order of Friars Minor (or the Franciscans). Two years later he helped St Clare establish a female community of Franciscans known as the Poor Clares. In 1224 whilst praying in La Verna, St Francis received the wounds of the crucified Lord, which caused him great pain in his final years. St Francis is famous also for his love of creation, and his empathy with animals. He is said to have formed a bond with a formerly ferocious wolf at Gubbio. When it was marauding the local flocks he persuaded the villagers to leave food out for the animal, and it gave no further trouble. In these and other instances of St Francis' life we see a foreshadowing of the new heavens and the new earth prophesied by Scripture, when the violence of the natural world will end in divine harmony.

### The Centenary Pilgrim Virgin Statue of the Immaculate Heart of Mary

### School admissions to Catholic Secondary Academies (Year 7) - Children born between 01/09/2011 and 31/08 2012

The deadline for submitting your application for a school place is 31<sup>st</sup> October 2022. Application forms are available on your 'home' Local Authority website. For every Catholic school you apply for if you wish your child to be considered and ranked under a faith criterion you *must also complete a supplementary information form*, and return this form to the school by the deadline, (forms are available from the LA and the school). You MUST also include the *supporting evidence* as required eg baptism certificate (photocopies are acceptable). Failure to supply the required supporting evidence will mean your child is ranked in a lower criterion which may affect your chance of a place. If you do not have the required evidence please contact the parish where your child was baptised for a copy certificate in good time.
