## St Luke - 18th October

St Luke was born at Antioch in Syria. He was a physician and a Greek-speaking Gentile. After his conversion to Christianity he became a follower of St Paul. He is referred to by St Paul in his letters as "the beloved physician." St Luke is the inspired writer of the third Gospel and also of the Acts of the Apostles. He was instructed by St Paul and the other apostles. Therefore, he wrote his Gospel from what he had heard from eyewitnesses. The Acts of the apostles was however written from first-hand experience. St Luke accompanied St Paul on his second and third missionary journeys. St Luke also looked after St Paul during his imprisonment in Rome from AD 61-63, when the apostle was released. This was also the year in which St Luke finished writing the Acts of the Apostles. St Luke continued to accompany St Paul even during his final imprisonment and execution. The Apostle wrote that all his other friends had abandoned him, but that Luke remained with him. After the martyrdom of St Paul tradition informs us that St Luke preached the Gospel in Italy, Gaul, Dalmatia and Macedonia. He was martyred near Achaia in Greece. The head of St Luke was brought to the Monastery of St Andrew in Rome by St Gregory. Mount Athos also holds some of his relics. St Luke was never married and lived to be eighty-four. He was also a skilled artist. There are several icons attributed to him of Our Lord and Our Blessed Lady.

### School admissions to Catholic Secondary Academies (Year 7) - Children born between 01/09/2011 and 31/08 2012

The deadline for submitting your application for a school place is 31<sup>st</sup> October 2022. Application forms are available on your 'home' Local Authority website. For every Catholic school you apply for if you wish your child to be considered and ranked under a faith criterion you *must also complete a supplementary information form*, and return this form to the school by the deadline, (forms are available from the LA and the school). You **MUST** also include the *supporting evidence* as required eg baptism certificate (photocopies are acceptable). Failure to supply the required supporting evidence will mean your child is ranked in a lower criterion which may affect your chance of a place. If you do not have the required evidence please contact the parish where your child was baptised for a copy certificate in good time.
