The Catholic Safeguarding Standards Agency (CSSA) have launched Safeguarding training to be completed by volunteers who require a DBS for their role. There are three webinars between 25th and 27th October which include Safeguarding Children in Church Communities, Safeguarding Adults in Church Communities and Creating a Safer Environment for Church Activities. School admissions to Catholic Secondary Academies (Year 7) ~ Children born between 01/09/2011 and 31/08 2012

The deadline for submitting your application for a school place is 31st October 2022. Application forms are available on your 'home' Local Authority website. For every Catholic school you apply for if you wish your child to be considered and ranked under a faith criterion you must also complete a supplementary information form, and return this form to the school by the deadline, (forms are available from the LA and the school). You MUST also include the supporting evidence as required eg baptism certificate (photocopies are acceptable). Failure to supply the required supporting evidence will mean your child is ranked in a lower criterion which may affect your chance of a place. If you do not have the required evidence please contact the parish where your child was baptised for a copy certificate in good time.

November – The Month of the Holy Souls November is traditionally the month when we remember

deceased family and friends. If you wish your loved ones to be remembered at Mass, please put your offering in a "November Dead List" envelope (which are available at the back of Church). The envelope can be placed in the collection basket as you leave Church and they will be placed in front of the Altar at all November Masses.
