### St Hugh of Lincoln 17th November

This month we celebrate the feast of St Hugh of Lincoln. He is both the patron of our Diocese and the one to whom two churches in this Diocese are dedicated. St Hugh was born at Avalon near Grenoble in 1140. Having been educated in a Church school, at the age of about twenty-five he became a Carthusian monk at the Grand Chartreuse in the French Alps. Carthusians live as hermits, only meeting each other to pray the office and rarely for official business of the monastery. He was invited to become the prior of the Carthusian house at Witham in Somerset. Under St Hugh's leadership this languishing monastery began to flourish. In 1186 Henry II chose Hugh as Bishop of the huge diocese of Lincoln, which at that time stretched down to London. St Hugh refused to accept this post as he believed the election to be uncanonical. Eventually he accepted under obedience to the prior of the Grande Chartreuse, the Carthusian mother-house. St Hugh set to work. He extended the Cathedral, which had been damaged in an earthquake. True to his Carthusian training he laboured on the enterprise with his own bare hands, alongside the other builders. He visited all regions of his vast diocese on horseback, to consecrate churches, to confirm, and to bury the dead. Always a friend of the oppressed he tended lepers, and risked his own life to save Lincoln's Jews from rioters. When the crowds surged into the Cathedral to demand all paperwork belonging to Jews, he threatened them with excommunication. The crowd soon backed down as many whom St Hugh had excommunicated had mysteriously died very shortly afterwards. St Hugh died in the year 1200. His coffin was carried at the funeral by King John, of whom he had been very critical in life. It is said that the famous swan which St Hugh had befriended during his life, never recovered from the loss, and never befriended anyone else. St Hugh is said to have predicted a catastrophe which would befall the Church in England because of its worldliness after his death. He also promised the people of Lincoln he would always watch over them, and assist them in their needs. St Hugh's life shows us the supreme importance of following the will of God no matter what. He had wanted to remain in the Carthusian cloister, having no desire to become a bishop. But once validly elected, he showed his holiness by approaching his new calling with great zeal.

### School admissions to Catholic Primary Academies (Reception Year) - Children born between 01/09/2018 and 31/08/2019

The deadline for submitting your application for a school place is **15th January 2023**. Application forms are available on your 'home' Local Authority website. For every Catholic school you apply for if you wish your child to be considered and ranked under a faith criterion you *must also complete a supplementary information form*, and return this form to the school by the deadline, (forms are available from the LA and the school). You MUST also include the *supporting evidence* as required eg baptism certificate (photocopies acceptable). Failure to supply the required evidence will mean your child is ranked in a lower criterion which may affect your chance of a place. If you do not have the required evidence please contact the parish where your child was baptised for a copy certificate in good time.
