### Fr Matthew's Catechism:

#### How and when will the world end?

We are living in worrying times with so many of the disasters predicted by Christ in St Matthew's Gospel having come true. These include firstly the destruction of the Jewish temple in Jerusalem, plagues, wars, earthquakes, and persecutions of the Church (see Matthew Chapter 24). But these prophecies are open to varied interpretations, so we cannot predict the end of the world with exactness. This is the way God intended it, as it best fulfils His providence. Jesus himself taught "Regarding that day and that hour, no one knows when it will come, not even the angels, not even the Son, but only the Father." (Mark 13 v. 32).

Nonetheless there are certain things which the Bible tells us about the end of the world which are quite definite. Since the Ascension of Christ into heaven we are in the end times, as Christ's coming in glory is now imminent. When Christ appeared to St John the apostle, in the last years of the first century, as he wrote the Book of Revelation, he declared "Yes, I am coming soon." (Rev. 22. V.20). These are the last verses of the Bible, and they put us on notice to expect Jesus' second coming at any time. It seems also that the Second Coming is delayed until the whole people of Israel accept Jesus as the Messiah (see Acts 3: 9-21 and Romans 11:15). Jesus also teaches there will also be an ultimate trial of the Church, which will shake the faith of many believers, "False prophets will appear and mislead many; and because of such great wickedness, love in many people will grow cold." (Matthew 24, vv. 11-12, see also Luke 18v.8). The Catechism of the Catholic Church summarizes the coming of the Kingdom, not as a triumph of the Church on earth, but as a direct intervention of God: "The Kingdom will be fulfilled, then, not by a historic triumph of the Church through a progressive ascendancy, but only by God's victory over the final unleashing of evil, which will cause his Bride to come down from heaven." (CCC. Para. 677)

The end of time will therefore come at a time appointed by God, which He alone knows, after a time of great evil and persecution of the Church. Jesus Christ will come down from heaven in power and great glory. He will gather his chosen ones from all over the earth (see Matthew 24: vv. 29-31).

#### School admissions to Catholic Primary Academies

##### (Reception Year) - Children born between

01/09/2018 and 31/08/2019

The deadline for submitting your application for a school place is **15<sup>th</sup> January 2023**. Application forms are available on your 'home' Local Authority website. For every Catholic school you apply for if you wish your child to be considered and ranked under a faith criterion you *must also complete a supplementary information form*, and return this form to the school by the deadline, (forms are available from the LA and the school). You **MUST** also include the *supporting evidence* as required eg baptism certificate (photocopies acceptable). Failure to supply the required evidence will mean your child is ranked in a lower criterion which may affect your chance of a place. If you do not have the required evidence please contact the parish where your child was baptised for a copy certificate in good time.
