St Lucy - Feast Day 13th December

St Lucy was probably born in Syracuse in Sicily, and martyred during the persecution of Diocletian in the early fourth century. According to legend, she was the daughter of a wealthy family and was brought up as a Christian. The account of her martyrdom dates from the fifth or sixth century. It states that while Lucy was on a pilgrimage to the tomb of St Agatha, the patroness of Catania in Italy, the Saint appeared to her. She told her that God would bless the city of Syracuse, as he had Catania, because of the virginal love of Lucy. Lucy then convinced her mother to give to the poor the money which had been set aside for her dowry. Her future husband was so annoyed that he brought her before the courts. Here she was arrested tortured and killed. Lucy exhibited remarkable courage in her trial and her torture for one so young (she was only in her teens). Her relics are venerated at Venice, and she is the patroness of all who suffer from eye afflictions.

St Lucy gives witness both to virginity and martyrdom. Since the third century virgins have been honoured in third place in the liturgy, after the apostles and the martyrs. When the persecutions ended in the fourth century, consecrated virginity represented a high degree of sanctity. That Lucy is both a virgin and a martyr shows her strength of character. This feast is celebrated as a festival of light in many countries, coming so close to the shortest day of the year.
