St Anthony ~ 17th January

One day in the year 269 St Anthony, the son of a wealthy Egyptian farmer, heard the words in the liturgy: "If you would be perfect, go, sell all that you have, and give to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven, and come, follow me." Anthony interpreted these words literally and radically. As a result, he became not just the spiritual father of those who followed him out into the desert, but the spiritual father of all monks, and religious in the Church.

There were ascetics and celibates who came before him, but he was the first one to create a rule of life which commended itself to the Church with obvious potential.

Leaving his younger sister in the charge of some Christian virgins he went out into the desert to lead a solitary life of prayer and penance. However, he was not as solitary as we might think. Soon there were other young men who emulated him and a community of monks formed around him. There were also many people who sought out his advice and spiritual guidance. We might think that going out into the harsh climate of the Egyptian desert and living on bread, water and vegetables might not be good for the health. But Anthony might have something to teach us here as well, after all, he did live to the age of 105!
