Our Lady of Lourdes

One of the most remarkable people I have ever met was a lady in a former parish. She wasn't remarkable for anything she had done. She was remarkable for something God had done for her. In the 1960's she was almost completely paralysed, and didn't have long to live. She was suffering from multiple sclerosis. Against her doctor's advice she decided to go on pilgrimage to Lourdes with the Nottingham Diocese. Those who have been on the pilgrimage will know that there are a number of processions and vigils, as well as silent prayer at the cave where Our Lady appeared to Saint Bernadette. The paralysed lady, Kath, was wheeled down to the Grotto as She was left in the dormitory on her own, and suddenly cared for. needed to go to the toilet. Without thinking she got up out of the wheelchair, and walked to the bathroom. She took her headscarf off, and starting to swing it around in her hand. Then she suddenly realized she was walking. Just then a nurse came in and said, "Mrs Spencer, what do you think you're doing. That's very dangerous. Get back in that wheelchair at once!" Then she too stopped and realized what had happened. Kath describes how she was bundled down to the medical bureau and poked and prodded for hours by doctors. They couldn't understand how she could

In thanksgiving for her miraculous cure Kath made a promise to Our Lady that she would go on the Diocesan Pilgrimage every year, and help with the sick, now that she was completely cured. She did this every year until in her late eighties old age made this no longer possible.

Yesterday was the memoria of Our Lady of Lourdes. The anniversary of the very first apparition of Our Lady to St Bernadette Soubirous. In all, in 1858, Our Lady appeared to St Bernadette eighteen times telling her to have a church built and to encourage people to come to Lourdes on pilgrimage, especially the sick. They were to pray the Rosary in procession, and to wash in the spring. Bernadette was only fourteen at the time. She hadn't really been brought up instructed in the faith. And Our Lady asked all this of her. Despite all the odds being stacked against her, she followed Our Lady's instructions, and now Lourdes is one of the largest pilgrimage destinations in the world.

May I take this opportunity to invite you on the Lourdes Pilgrimage this year. The message of Lourdes is for everyone. Whether we are sick or in good health. Whether we have serious problems or whether we don't. At some stage we will all have to come to terms with suffering and illness and life's problems, which unfortunately are part of everyone's lot. Not everyone in Paelstine at the time of Christ was cured by Jesus. Not everyone who goes to Lourdes is physically cured. In fact true miracles, which bear proper scientific investigation are quite rare. But everyone who goes to Lourdes in a spirit of faith comes under the maternal care of Our Lady in a special way. The problems of life seem lighter after the pilgrimage. Faith is strengthened, and the joy comes back into our lives in the light of God's presence. Sufferings are easier to bear. In the light of faith, they can be seen to have a purpose. They are part of the story of our salvation and that of the world. The effect of the pilgrimage is to be reminded that we are truly God's children, and we also have Mary as our Mother. Therefore we can go through life with faith, serenity and joy, accepting God's will for us.

Sts Cyril and Methodius ~ 14th February

These two brothers evangelised Moravia, Bohemia, and Bulgaria and are venerated as the "Apostles of the Slavs." They translated the liturgical books into the Slavonic language with the help of the Cyrillic alphabet, which they invented. St Cyril died in Rome where he had gone to seek the Pope's blessing. St Methodius, who died in 885, was consecrated a bishop and ended his days in Hungary, then known as Pannonia. St John Paul II named them co-patrons of Europe along with St Benedict. This feast reminds us of the great

task of evangelisation which is the responsibility of all of us each in our own sphere of influence.
