Sts Perpetua and Felicity - 7th March

These two saints faced martyrdom hand in hand at Carthage in North Africa during the persecution of the Roman Emperor Septimus Severus, dying in about the year 202 AD. The account of their deaths was probably written by Tertullian and was read publicly in the North African churches in the fourth century.

Perpetua was 22 years of age at her martyrdom. She was the daughter of a pagan nobleman, and the mother of an infant still in swaddling clothes. Felicity, a slave, gave birth prematurely to a child whilst in prison. Perpetua and Felicity were catechumens and were imprisoned along with three other catechumens, and their teacher, Saturus. All five were baptized in prison prior to their martyrdoms in the amphitheater. As Felicity was giving birth, a prison guard begged her 2023. For further information please ring 01652 652817 or to avoid death for the sake of her unborn child. She replied, "Today it is I who suffer in giving birth, but then it will be another who will suffer in me, because I shall suffer for Him."
