This will mean that Sunday Mass times will have to change and the number of Masses reduced. The proposed Mass times for this area will be announced in next week's bulletin after further consultation between Canon Matthew and the people of our Church communities. Because we have not had time for thorough consultation before the change must happen, it is worth stating at this stage that the new Sunday Mass times will be subject to review and more in depth consulta-tion, after a three month period has elapsed. It is worth emphasizing that each of our Church communities will be guaranteed a Sunday Mass at the end of the process.

St Bernadette's Parish Hall

The Diocese of Nottingham has taken the decision, after consultation with Canon Matthew, St Bernadette's Parish Council and Finance Committee, to make the hall secretary and caretaker redundant. The hall has made a loss of over £12,000 in the ten month period from 1st April 2022 to the end of January 2023. This loss is largely because of a dramatic decline in hall income from private hire since the pandemic, and rising maintenance/utility costs. Such a loss is clearly unsustainable for the parish, and there was no other choice but to take this unfortunate step.
