#### Canon Matthew's Catechism - The fruits of Holy Communion

In paragraph 1390 of the Catechism, we read, "Since Christ is sacramentally present under each of the species, communion under the species of bread alone makes it possible to receive all the fruit of Eucharistic grace. For pastoral reasons this manner of receiving communion has been legitimately established as the most common form in the Latin 🔀 rite." In other words, we lack nothing if we receive Holy Communion under the form of bread alone, because we receive the whole Christ. Having consulted people about the option of returning to the practice of communion under both kinds, I have decided to keep to the practice of receiving under the form of bread alone for practical reasons for the time being at least, and thereby to uphold the normative practice of the Latin Rite to which most Catholics in these church communities belong. What are the fruits of receiving Holy Communion? The main fruit of receiving Holy Communion is an intimate union with Jesus Christ, who said "He who eats my flesh and drinks my blood abides in me, and I in him." (Jn. 6:56). When we receive Holy Communion we must remember we are receiving none other than the flesh of the risen Christ. Just as bodily food strengthens us physically and gives us health, so this spiritual food preserves and increases the life of grace we received at baptism.
