Easter Message from Fr Matthew

would like to thank everyone for their kindness, support and prayers in the past few difficult weeks, as we have all had to adjust to there being one resident priest in this part of the world. Thank you also to everyone who has helped in some way in the Holy Week and Easter liturgies, and for your kindness and generosity to me personally.

Foday we celebrate the great feast of Easter. The ancient Easter greeting is "Alleluia, the Lord is risen." The traditional 🕅 reply is "He is risen indeed!" We make this reply on behalf of all mankind, and all creation. Christ's Resurrection is so 🕅 3 powerful that it affects the whole cosmos, even those who have already died. The Scriptures tell us that after Christ died and entered the realm of the dead, many holy people rose from the dead and appeared to their living relatives and friends in Jerusalem (see Matthew 27: 51-53). I have frequently wondered at the reactions of those who had known these holy dead, and whether they would have realised that this was all happening precisely because God had died in 🕅 order to vanquish death on our behalf. Whatever the answers to this question, the astounding fact is that Jesus is risen indeed! So happy Easter to you all from me. And remember that Easter doesn't end on Easter Monday. During the Easter Octave (the eight day period from Easter Sunday up to and including Divine Mercy Sunday), we continue to celebrate as if it were Easter day itself. The Church gives us this eight-day period as a holiday and a time of rest. The number eight is a symbol of eternity and rest. We may be called upon to work within this period, but let us hold on to the fact that our primary duty is to rest and celebrate as a foretaste of the Kingdom of Heaven, and our eternal rest.
