The life of St Norbert ~ Feast day 6th June

- St Norbert is the patron of our parish and school situated in Crowle, which was established by priests of the order he founded known as the Premonstratensions or Norbertines. St Norbert was born in Xanten, Germany, in 1080, into a noble family. He had no desire to become a priest. All this changed when was riding his horse in the countryside one day. There was a violent thunderstorm. His horse threw him and he lay unconscious on the ground. This was his Road to Damascus moment. When he came round his first words were "Lord what do you want me to do?" An inner voice replied "Turn away from evil and do good. Seek peace and pursue it."
- St Norbert's conversion was as dramatic and complete as that of St Paul. St Norbert gave away all his estates and possessions and trained for the priesthood.
- In 1119 St Norbert was given permission to found a community in the Diocese Laon. He established himself in a lonely valley called Premontre in the Forest of Coucy, with some thirteen disciples. Numbers soon increased. On Christmas Day 1121 forty made their profession in the fledgling community. They wore a white habit and kept the rule of St Augustine with some additional regulations. The new order gained several influential disciples, both men and women. St Norbert died in 1134 after a life of action and contemplation. His body was carried to Magdeburg where it lay in the church of his Order. After the city became Lutheran in 1627, Norbert's relics were taken to the Premonstratensian abbey of Strabov in Bohemia. St Norbert was canonized by Pope Gregory in 1582.
