St Anthony of Padua - 13th June

St Anthony died near Padua, Italy, on June 13th 1231, at the early age of thirty-six. He was canonized the following year by Pope Gregory IX. He was born in Lisbon, and as a young man became an Augustinian friar. He was deeply affected by the sight of the bodies of five Franciscan protomartyrs that were brought back from Morocco. He decided to join the Franciscan Order and took the name Anthony.

He departed from the Franciscan mission in Morocco, but soon returned due to poor health. He took part in the general chapter of the Franciscans at Portiuncula in 1221, where he met St Francis. He was ordained to the priesthood in Italy, and began a preaching ministry throughout Italy and France, and into the stronghold of the Albigensian heretics. In 1227 he returned to Italy, where he achieved great fame due to his preaching at Padua. He died in the city, which gave him a triumphal funeral in 1231. St Anthony's preaching made an impact wherever he went, but he himself said, "Actions speak louder than words: let your words teach and your actions speak."
