Catechism on parts of the Mass: The Gloria

The Gloria is an ancient Christian hymn. Many scholars think it is the earliest of Christian hymns. It is like a patchwork quilt of different parts of Scripture. It is composed entirely of the writings of St John the apostle and St Paul. The Gloria became part of the Sunday Mass on solemnities and feasts from the time of Pope Symmachus in the sixth century. (A solemnity is a major feast of the Church. Examples are all Sundays throughout the year, and feasts like Sts Peter and Paul and All Saints). The Gloria praises and entreats both God the Father and Jesus the Lamb. It begins with the song the angels sang on Christmas night: Glory to God in the highest And on earth peace to people of good will. (Lk. 2.14) We praise you we bless you We adore you, we glorify you (Ps 148.13) Lord Jesus Christ, Only begotten Son. (John 1.14) Lord God, Lamb of God, Son of the Father You take away the sins of the world. (John 1.29) And so it continues. From this extract we see how the Gloria is an ancient Christian hymn, composed of different elements of Scripture. It has been part of the Sunday Mass for over one and a half thousand years. It is also worth noting that as a hymn, the Gloria should be sung where this is possible.
