Canon Matthew's Catechism

How can we tell what belongs to the true faith?

The true faith is contained in Sacred Scripture and Tradition. We must remember that the first Christians did not have the Bible as we have it now. They only had the Old Testament. Gradually additions were made to Scripture in the form of the four Gospels and the letters of the Apostles etc, but this was a process of many centuries. The early Christians kept to the teachings which were handed down by the Apostles. These were the twelve men who were called to be Jesus' closest collaborators. Tradition is used in a technical sense here. It doesn't mean "what we have always done", it means the teaching handed down by the apostles to the Church, and preserved in a living Tradition. Sacred Tradition and Sacred Scripture are intimately related to one another and "flow from the same divine wellspring." (Dei Verbum, Vatican II). What is found within Scripture and Tradition is the true faith of Christians because it is given us by the Holy Spirit.
